Guiding Principles

SOCIAL

Transit oriented development that creates a sense of personal identity and value within the community including security, choice, social opportunities, practical resources, sense of pride and a state of well being.



Guiding Principles

ECONOMIC

A transit system that promotes economic opportunities by creating jobs, public/private partnerships that invest resources in communities, encourage developer commitment to diverse housing options and business types, and supports locally sustained economies.



Guiding Principles

ENVIRONMENTAL

Use regional transit investment to foster comfortable, dense, sustainable and vibrant community enhancement.

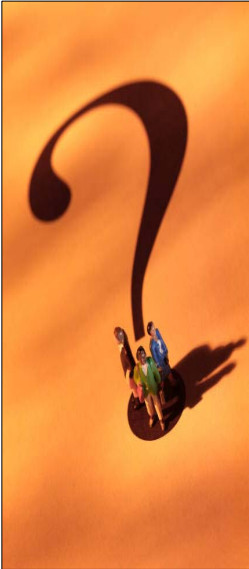
