#### *City Staff:*

4. **Joel Davidow** - City staff – planning department
5. **Craig Johnson** - City staff – public works department
6. **Jeff Golian** - City staff – economic development
7. **Edward B. Mower** - City staff – Mayor's representative or city manager

#### *Neighborhood Interests:*

8. **Mary Jane Loevlie** - Registered Neighborhood Organization (RNO) President -- represents the neighborhood as a whole or the views/opinions of the RNO Board
9. **M. Brandon Neill** - RNO subcommittee (transportation or land-use) chair – represents the views/opinions of the subcommittee
10. **Ethan Crawford** - Neighbor that lives next to the project – supports the project because of the increase property values that the project will bring; not involved in the RNO

15. **Melinda Pollack** - Family and child-friendly advocate – what amenities will the project offer to meet the needs of families and children
16. **Melinda Pollack** - Affordable Housing advocate – what aspects of the project will offer choices to workforce housing
17. **Brannen Ulrick** - Bike and pedestrian advocate – what amenities will be available to connect existing neighborhoods and bike/ped networks in the area
