

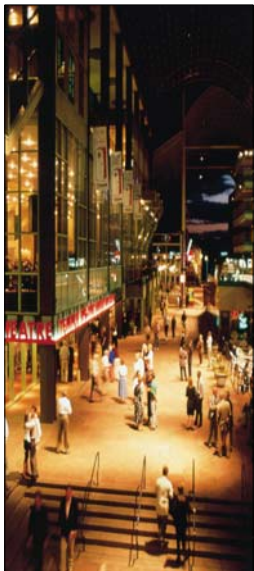

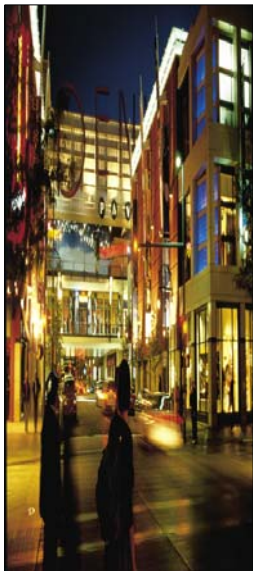

- ❖ Work with the entire group to create a final list that we can all support.

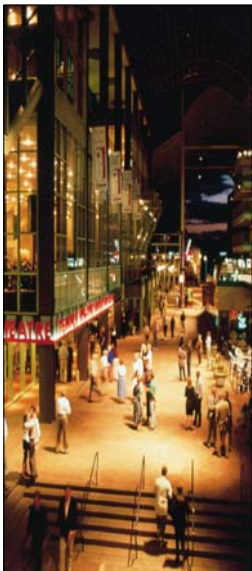


## Reshaping Metro Denver: The Legacy of Transit Oriented Development
